IT'S SHOEBOX PACKING SUNDAY!!! PLEASE JOIN US IN PACKING THE SHOEBOXES AFTER CHURCH SERVICES AND SHARE THE BLESSINGS.

THIS IS THE PROCEDURE FOR PACKING BOXES:

If you follow this guide in packing, children will receive all items that have been prepared for each box. Please follow the numbers on the walls so that certain items that have been prepared will be in each box. This is important.

- 1. PICK A BOX BOY OR GIRL, AGES 2-4; 5-9; 10-14. Left side of room, then proceed around room. Boxes are lined on wall under NO. 1 by age and gender. Some of the boxes have black inside tops. This is chalkboard so be sure they have chalk and eraser in them.
- 2. In this area, **put a card in bottom, pack of paper, then, put a pencil pouch in bottom** so it will fit better. Please be sure to put a pencil pouch in each box. These pouches contain pencils, scissor, erasers, pens, etc.
- 3. These tables have <u>cups with tee shirts, eating utensils, underwear by size & gender.</u> Read the signs for ages and gender. Please make sure this goes in each box. A new shirt is important.
- 4. <u>Stage area</u>: Please put one of each thing in box as long as items last. Combs, brushes, nail clippers, washcloths, stuffed animals, etc.
- 5. The tables in the middle of room are full of toys and other items. Some marked by age. Please fill in the box with these items. Fit items in so the boxes are full.
- 6. <u>CHECK OUT. Turn in full boxes at this table and start over again.</u> We will pack boxes until boxes start looking skimpy.
- 7. PRAY FOR THE BOXES AND THE CHILDREN WHO RECEIVE THEM.

Thank you to all who have helped with this year long project. Those who sorted and prepared items for the boxes; donated items or money; put boxes together; donated to yard sale to support these boxes and those who worked the yard sale. It is a team effort and everyone was a great help.
